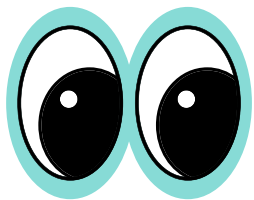


VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR A RESEARCH STUDY ON EYE TRACKING!
